

## Wecome to Gudenå!

All motor-driven vessels to be used in the Gudenå must be registered prior to launch. This applies to both resident vessels and guests who wish to launch their vessels in the river for shorter time.

Registration must be done on [www.sejladspaagudenaen.dk](http://www.sejladspaagudenaen.dk) - the Gudenå system's boat register.

Registering a resident vessel costs a yearly fee of 200 DKK, while guest vessels are registered with a guest number (30 DKK, valid for 14 days). Guests in the Gudenå system are those that do not live, or have a permanent berth for their vessel, in one of the seven Gudenå municipalities.

Your allocated registration number must be placed on both sides of the bow of your vessel.



The municipalities and the police carry out regular inspections of registrations. Vessels without registration numbers, or who have not paid their yearly fee, will incur a fine of 1000 DKK.

## The Gudenå Committee

The Gudenå Committee is a cooperation between the seven municipalities along the river: Randers, Viborg, Favrskov, Silkeborg, Skanderborg, Horsens, and Hedensted.

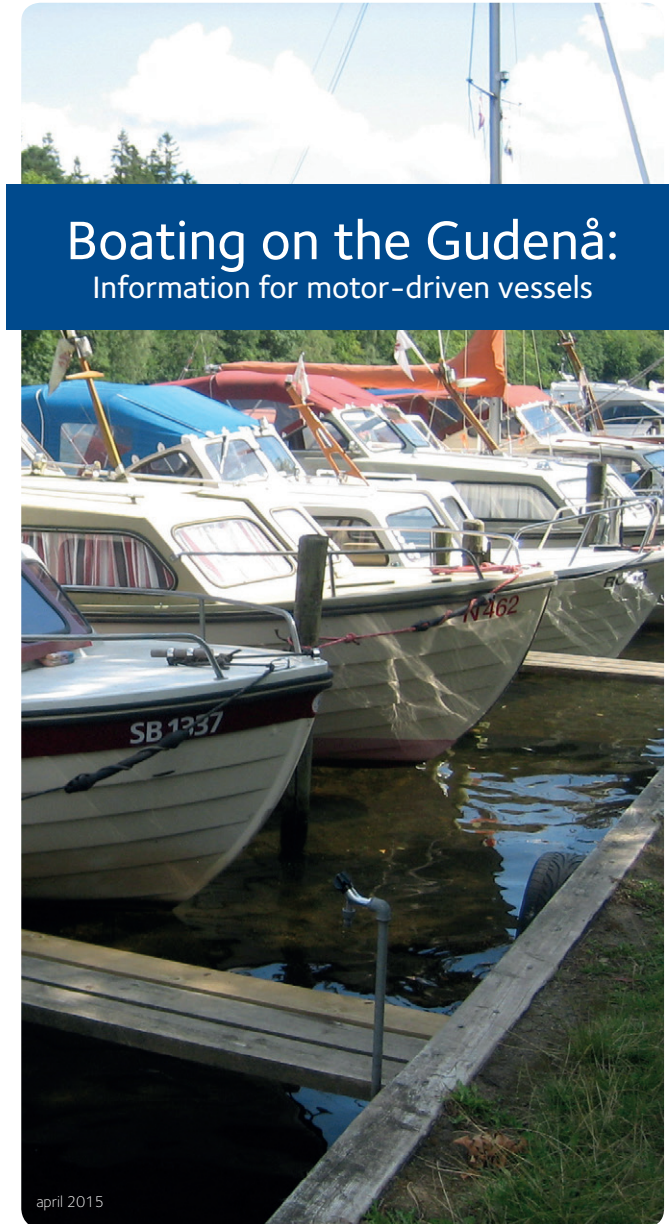
The focus of the Gudenå committee is the use and protection of the river Gudenå.

Navigating the unmarked  
areas of this map with a  
motor-driven vessel is  
forbidden.

Please be aware that:

It is not permitted to  
navigate in water with  
rush or reeds or to  
disembark in these areas  
out of respect for birds  
and for the environment.

It is only permitted to  
disembark where there is  
permission from the  
landowner or at public  
docks and slipways.

Obey restricted areas  
and speed limits out of  
respect for other boaters  
and for the environment.

There must be a lifejacket  
for everyone on board.

You must have a  
speedboat license if your  
boat so requires.

Avoid creating waves  
near canoes, kayaks, etc.
