

Welcome to the Gudenå River!

Remember to register your boat

All vessels with an engine that are using the Gudenå system must be registered before they are launched in the river. This applies to both resident vessels, or vessels that are guests on the Gudenå for a short time. You can register using the Gudenå's registration system at www.sejladspaagudenaen.dk.

Registering resident vessels costs an annual fee of 200 DKK. Guest vessels are registered with a guest registration number. These cost 30 DKK and are valid for 14 days. If you neither have residency or a permanent berth in the Gudenå system, your vessel is a guest vessel.

The allocated registration number must be fixed to the boat prior to launch, and they must be placed in on both sides of the boat's bow.

The municipalities and police carry out checks to make sure that vessels are registered correctly. Navigating the river without a registration number, or without having paid the annual fee, will incur a fine of 1000 DKK.

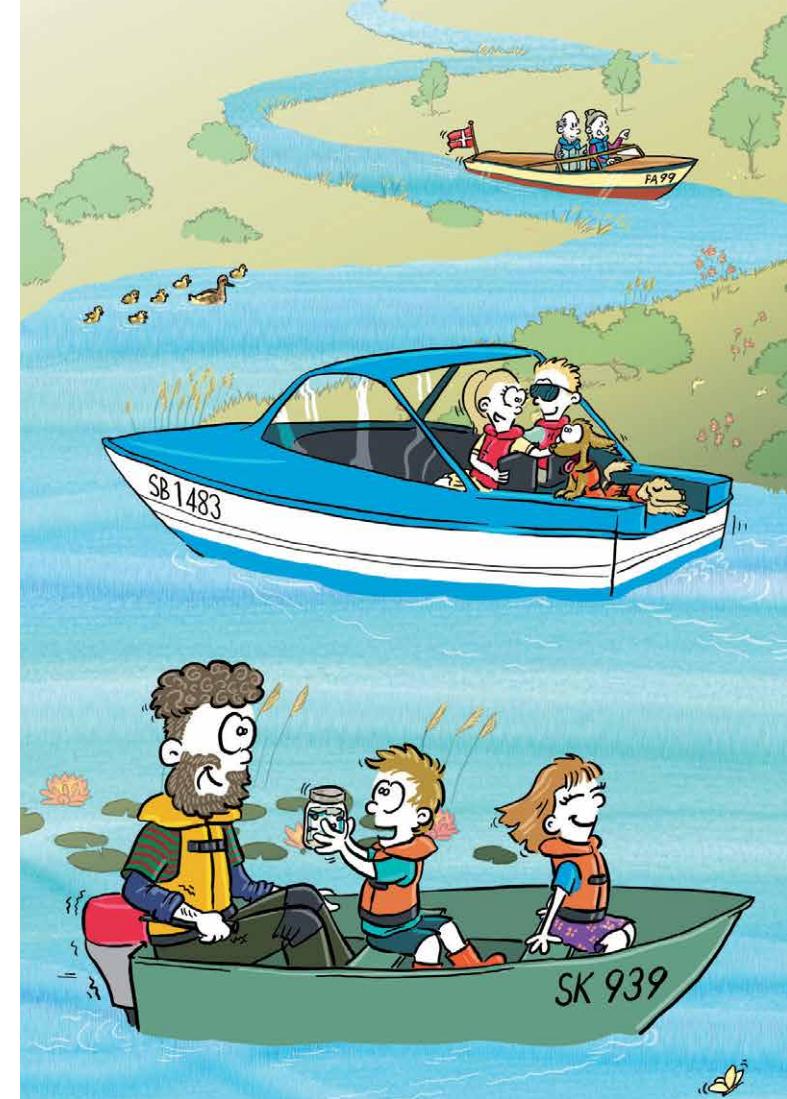

Speed limits on the Gudenå River and Randers Fjord

-  10 Knots
-  8 Knots
-  7 Knots
-  6 Knots
-  5 Knots
-  Motorboats forbidden
-  Launch site

It is forbidden to navigate motor-driven vessels on lakes and rivers that are unmarked on this map.

Please be aware:

- Out of consideration for birds and the natural environment, it is not permitted to navigate areas with rush or reeds, or launch or land here.
- You are only permitted to land where you have permission from the landowner, or on public docks and slipways.
- Out of respect for nature and other users of the river, respect the areas where navigation is forbidden, and abide by the speed limits.
- You must have buoyancy aids for everyone on board.
- You must have a speed boat license if your boat so requires.
- Please avoid making waves near canoes, kayaks, etc.
