

Your boat must be registered before navigating the Gudenå

All vessels with an engine must be registered on the Gudenå's boat register before being launched. You can register here: www.sejladspaagudenaen.dk.

There are two types of registration:

- **Permanent registration.** If you are a resident, or have a summer house or permanent berth in one of the Gudenå municipalities (Randers, Viborg, Favrskov, Silkeborg, Skanderborg, Horsens or Hedensted), you may apply for permanent registration. This registration must be renewed annually.

Cost: Annual fee of 200 DKK per vessel. You must factor in time for processing the renewal of your registration.

Please be aware: Owners must paint, or procure and affix, the registration number on the vessel.

- **Guest registration.** Guests are those visiting the Gudenå for a shorter period, or those who otherwise do not fulfil the criteria for permanent registration.

Cost: 30 DKK per vessel for a 14 day permit. You do not need to factor in time for processing the application – you can print your guest registration number immediately.

Regardless of the type, a registration number is made up of a combination of letters and numbers. Registration numbers must be visible on both sides of the bow of the vessel, and must be affixed before the vessel is launched in the Gudenå system.

The police and municipalities carry out regular inspections on boat registrations. Navigating the Gudenå system without a registration number, or with an unpaid annual fee will incur a fine of 1000 DKK.

It is NOT permitted to navigate motorised vessels on rivers and lakes that are unmarked on this map.

Launch sites differ in relation to access to the area, cost and payment, and capacity of the site. You can find information about the launch sites on www.sejladspaagudenaen.dk or using the QR code.

Please remember:

- Out of consideration for birds and the environment, it is not permitted to navigate areas with rush or reeds, or launch or land here.
- You are only permitted to land where you have permission from the landowner, or on public docks and slipways.
- Out of respect for nature and other users of the river, respect the areas where navigation is forbidden, and abide by the speed limits.
- You must have buoyancy aids for everyone on board.
- You must have a speedboat license if your boat so requires.
- Please avoid making waves near canoes, kayaks, etc.
